This \$1,500.00 scholarship is to be awarded to a student regardless of race, color, religion, sex, handicap, familial status, or national origin, whose educational goals are directed toward the betterment of the community. The student should also be enrolled at Heidelberg University, Terra Community College, Tiffin University or the University of Findlay for the fall quarter of the 2010 school year.

The student should be a high school senior with the potential for college work at the time of application and will be judged on the essay portion of the application. The decision of the Selection Committee in awarding this scholarship is final. Should the Selection Committee have applications not meeting the scholarship criteria or have no applications for a given year, The Old Fort Banking Company Scholarship will be forfeited for the 2010 school year.

Only students from school districts served by financial centers of The Old Fort Banking Company are eligible to apply for this scholarship. Those high schools are: Arcadia, Arlington, Bettsville, Calvert, Clyde-Green Springs, Columbian, Cory Rawson, Findlay, Fostoria, Fremont Ross, Hopewell-Loudon, Lakota, Liberty Benton, McComb, Mohawk, New Riegel, Old Fort, Seneca East, Fremont St. Joseph, St. Wendelin, Van Buren and Vanlue High School. The Selection Committee will be made up of Heidelberg University's Director of Financial Aid, Tiffin University's Career Placement Director and the Vice President for Academic Affairs, Terra Community College's Assistant Director of Financial Aid, and the CEO of the Seneca Industrial and Economic Development Corporation (SIEDC). The deadline for applications is **Friday, April 09, 2010**. Applications must be postmarked on or before this date.
